Attached is my typed Statement of Candidacy.

Please note, that while I am filing this Statement of Candidacy it is with determination that I shall not comply with certain things and as such you will have to file a suit of law in federal court in the State of Oklahoma should you feel that the laws are just. They would be countered by me in a very public way as willful violation of Constitutional Rights and deliberate efforts of Elitists trying to ensure ordinary citizens shall not be able to compete equally with elitist candidates who are willing to participate in the elimination of the Constitution of the United States and undermining of the rights of Citizens who are not part of the secretive elitist world.

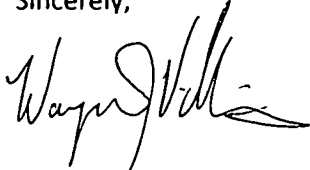
It amazes me how willing so many people are to ignore or to find reason to redefine what is actually written in the United States Constitution or the Declaration of Independence.

Part 7: Campaign Committee Information:

- a) As of yet, there is no Campaign Committee. This is expected to be assigned by the Democratic Party. They are being informed at the same time as I am filing this Statement of Candidacy.
- b) Note, that I shall not form nor comply with the rules associated with forming a Committee as that violates my Constitutional Rights including the right to become a Candidate for the Office of President of the United States.
- c) Regardless of the amount of funds used to support my campaign for US President, I inform you of my intent to run for the office. Any funds donated to support my plan to run for President shall be construed as a personal financial gift to me to be used as I see fit, should such funds be gifted directly to me. Any committee formed by the Democrat Party Affiliations or other persons shall be responsible for their funds according to the rules for Committees.
- d) Designations of Authorized Committees shall be provided by the Committees so formed to assist in my campaign for the Office of United States President.

Part 8: Expectations of performance from the Federal Election Commission:

- a) It is also expected that I, as a candidate for United States President, shall not provide my personal financial statements as that violates the 4th Amendment of the United States Constitution, the honoring of which may not be used as an excuse to deny a citizen the right to engage in protected Speech, Press or other activities associated with running for any office of trust.

- b) It is expected that the FEC shall notify all States and Territories to include my candidacy on their primary ballots and the combined cost for doing so shall not exceed \$20, per the 7th Amendment of the United States Constitution.
 - c) It is expected that the FEC shall assist in ensuring that at no time shall the Constitution of the United States shall be in any way violated or infringed upon by the enactment of any subordinate legislation and as every person who is serving in Congress or working in any capacity for the Congress shall have given the Oath of Office of Defending the United States Constitution, it is therefore the Federal Election Committee's responsibility to protect the Constitution from infringement by legislative action without and prior to any court related review of the legislation. Furthermore, to suggest the Courts are responsible for determining the Constitutionality of Law ignores the legal opinion of the United States Supreme Court in 1803, Marberry Vs. Maddison where the court states that, "any person, having given the oath [of office: "I solemnly swear or affirm to ... Defend the Constitution from all enemies whether foreign or domestic."] who shall give authority to laws [passed by congress] equal to or greater than the Constitution itself, not only makes a mockery [Of the Constitution], but is committing a crime."
 - d) The US Supreme Court has ruled that the Bill of Rights, among other things, creates the Rights of Privacy. It seems that Elements of the Elites seem to have forgotten this is pushing their rules for Elections. Just because a person runs for Public Office or becomes a public figure does not mean they forgo so much as a single letter of rights that all Americans are supposed to enjoy. "The rights and privilege of One Citizen are the rights and privilege of All Citizens" – United States Constitution, Article 4 Section 2.

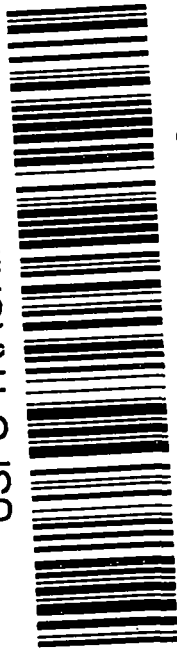
