

The following is an explanation of immediate corrective action taken by the U.S.-Cuba Democracy PAC ("PAC") pursuant to a request for additional information by the FEC (dated June 5th, 2009) on the Amended 2008 October Quarterly Report:

1. On September 15th, 2008, the PAC made a \$2,500 contribution to the federal House campaign of "Boustany Jr., Dr. Charles." The PAC disclosed this contribution, which was within the limit permissible by law, for the 2008 Primary election. The Louisiana House Primary election was held on October 4th, 2008 (it was rescheduled from the original September 6th, 2008 date due to storm damage following Hurricane Gustav). As a result, the September 15th PAC contribution was made prior to the October 4th, 2008 Primary election in Louisiana. No further contributions were made to this campaign committee for the 2008 election cycle. Therefore, the total permitted by the Federal Election Campaign Act ("FECA") to be contributed by the PAC to this campaign for both the 2008 Primary and General elections are well below the legal limitations.

2. On August 21st, 2008, the PAC made a \$2,500 contribution to the federal Senate campaign of "Menendez, Robert." Due to a clerical oversight, the PAC incorrectly disclosed this contribution for the 2006 Primary election. The PAC had intended the contribution to be disclosed for the 2012 Primary election. The recipient campaign committee correctly disclosed the contribution for the 2012 Primary election. The correction has been made by the PAC and further amended in the 2008 October Quarterly Report. The total permitted by the Federal Election Campaign Act ("FECA") to be contributed by the PAC to this campaign for both the 2012 Primary and General elections are well below the legal limitations.
