Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 items:

1. Schedule B supporting Line 23 of your report discloses contributions to an apparent "leadership" political action committee; however, you have disclosed the name of a federal candidate in the candidate name field. Please clarify whether these were earmarked contributions made by your committee through this committee to this candidate, or if you made these contributions to this political committee exercising no direction or control over how the funds were to be used. If the latter is the case, please only include the name of the apparent leadership PAC on Schedule B. Please amend your report to clarify the ultimate recipient of this contribution.
2. Your report discloses a possible in-kind contribution on Schedule B, supporting line 23 of your report. If this entry is an in-kind contribution, please provide the name, office sought (i.e. House, Senate or President), state, and district, if applicable, for the recipient candidate. Please amend your report to clarify this entry.
3. Your report disclosed a category of financial activity that has been reflected on the wrong line of the Detailed Summary Page. Transfers to affiliated/other party committees should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule B, supporting Line 22 of the Detailed Summary Page.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
