This Miscellaneous Document (Form 99) responds to the above-referenced RFAI, dated July 1, 2026, concerning the committee's 12-Day Pre-Runoff Report. The committee's corrective action on each item is described below.

ITEM 1 - APPARENT EXCESSIVE CONTRIBUTIONS FROM INDIVIDUALS

Kevin Buse: The excessive portion of Mr. Buse's runoff contributions was properly redesignated to the 2026 general election on May 8, 2026, following the close of this reporting period. The redesignation is disclosed on the committee's July Quarterly Report.

Raford Hargrove: The excessive portion of Mr. Hargrove's runoff contributions was properly redesignated to the 2026 general election on May 8, 2026, following the close of this reporting period. The redesignation is disclosed on the committee's July Quarterly Report.

William Wright: The two contributions aggregated under this name were made by two different individuals - a father and his adult son. The contribution dated 12/30/2025 (\$3,500, General) was made by William Wright, and the contribution dated 5/4/2026 (\$1,500, General) was made by William Brax Wright. They are separate persons, and neither individual's contribution exceeds the \$3,500 per-election limit.

ITEM 2 - APPARENT EXCESSIVE CONTRIBUTIONS FROM COMMITTEES NOT QUALIFIED FOR MULTI-CANDIDATE STATUS

AG PAC: AG PAC is not a qualified multi-candidate committee and is therefore subject to the \$3,500 per-election limit. The \$5,000 contribution received 4/13/2026 was designated entirely to the runoff due to a scrivener error. The contribution has been correctly designated \$3,500 to the 2026 runoff and \$1,500 to the 2026 general election. An amended report reflecting the corrected designation has been filed today.

Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association Federal PAC (DBA Cattle Raisers Federal PAC): This PAC is not a qualified multi-candidate committee and is therefore subject to the \$3,500 per-election limit. The PAC made two contributions during the cycle: a December 2025 contribution of \$5,000, properly designated \$3,500 to the primary and \$1,500 to the runoff; and a contribution of \$3,500 received 4/13/2026. Due to a scrivener error, the 4/13/2026 contribution was designated entirely to the runoff, which - together with the \$1,500 already designated to the runoff from the December contribution - brought the runoff total to \$5,000, exceeding the \$3,500 per-election limit by \$1,500. To correct this, \$1,500 of the 4/13/2026 contribution has been redesignated to the 2026 general election, so that the 4/13/2026 contribution is now designated \$2,000 to the runoff and \$1,500 to the general election. As corrected, none of the PAC's contributions exceeds the \$3,500 per-election limit (primary \$3,500, runoff \$3,500, general \$1,500). An amended report reflecting the corrected designation has been filed today.

The committee believes the amended report and this response fully address the matters raised in the RFAI.
