On December 13, 1995 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

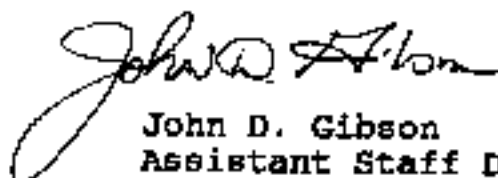
Your December 14, 1995 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-Pursuant to 11 CFR §110.6 (c) all earmarked contributions, that have passed through a conduit's account, must be itemized on the receipt and disbursement schedules. Your report disclosed the receipt of earmarked contributions on Schedule A, but does not include any corresponding itemized disbursements on Schedule B. All earmarked contributions must be forwarded to the recipient candidate committee within 10 days of receiving the contribution. (11 CFR §102.8(a) and (c). Please provide further clarifying information regarding the omitted disbursement schedules (i.e., file copies of Schedules B where earmarked contributions are reported) for all earmarked contributions disclosed by your committee.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
