2. Schedule A of your report discloses a receipt(s) from "Carlson, Lara K," with a negative aggregate year-to-date total(s) which appears to reflect a voided contribution made in a prior year. Please be advised that the aggregate year-to-date total for a contributor should reflect only those contributions received within that calendar year. Please amend your report to provide the correct aggregate year-to-date total.

Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**
