Please amend Schedule E by providing an indication of either support or opposition for the expenditure made with regard to Susan Davis. 11 CFR § 104.3(b)(3)(vii)

-Schedule B supporting Line 23 of your report discloses a contribution(s) to Team 2000. Please clarify whether this is a federal committee(s), as there does not appear to be a committee(s) registered with the Commission under this name(s). In the event this is a non-federal committee(s), please disclose it on Schedule B supporting Line 29 of the Detailed Summary Page.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
