Dear Mr. Harkins:

This is in response to your request for additional information dated September 3, 2025.

1. Your letter indicates that the Committee disclosed one or more contributions that appear to exceed the limits set forth in the act. The Committee is aware of the contribution limits. In the case of an individual, if the contribution cannot be presumptively reattributed to a spouse or redesignated to a subsequent election, the Committee either sends a verified reattribution letter or refunds the excessive portion within 60 days of receipt. The Committee sends all presumptive reattribution and redesignation letters within 30 days or receipt and always gives the donor the option of making a change or requesting a refund. When the Committee receives contributions from other political committees that cause an excessive total, the Committee contacts the other political committee and requests a verified redesignation. If this is not received, the Committee issues a refund. All donors listed as excessive in this letter have either been reattributed, redesignated or refunded. The following is a response to each contributor listed in your letter:

Duane Andrews: The excessive portion was redesignated to the general on 7/3/25 and will be disclosed on the October 15, 2025 FEC filing.

Judy Bond: The excessive portion was redesignated to the general on 7/3/25 and will be disclosed on the October 15, 2025 FEC filing.

William Curran: This was a duplicate donor in our system and has been corrected. The excessive portion was redesignated to the general on 7/3/25 and will be disclosed on the October 15, 2025 FEC filing.

Charles Duncan: The excessive portions have been redesignated to the general or charged back as applicable and will be disclosed on the October 15, 2025 FEC filing.

Paul Finger: A refund in the amount of \$4719.23 was issued 8/9/25 and will be disclosed on the October 15, 2025 FEC Filing.

Verne Istock: The excessive portion has been returned to the joint committee and will be reallocated to other participants.

Mark Jones: The excessive portion was redesignated to the general on 7/3/25 and will be disclosed on the October 15, 2025 FEC filing.

Bashir Khan: This donor is not excessive. It appears that the FEC has double counted four contributions from 3/31/25 in the amounts of 5.21, 5.21, 10.41 and 10.41.

If the Committee receives the partner attribution after the original contribution has been disclosed, the partner details will be disclosed as memo entries on a future report.
3. Your letter indicates that the Committee accepted contributions from political committees that are not registered with the Federal Election Commission. The Committee verified that these contributions were made with permissible funds and that each contributing organization had sufficient funds subject to federal limitations and requirements to issue

4. Your letter indicates that the dates of the transfers from the Committee back to a joint committee to remedy an excessive contribution are not clear. These were not refunds issued to the contributors and therefore are not disclosed on line 20a.

Kristen Chadwick: This was not an excessive contribution and was transferred back to the joint committee based on a donor designation correction. The contribution was returned to the joint committee with the 5/31/25 distribution.

Deloitte PAC: The contribution was transferred back to the joint committee on the 6/23/25 distribution. The PAC designated the contribution to a different JFC participant.

Thomas Smith: The contribution was transferred back to the joint committee on the 6/23/25 distribution.

5. The loss due to a fraudulent check processed, disclosed on the above referenced report, occurred because a check issued to a vendor was stolen from that vendor and used to create a fraudulent check. There was no improper use of funds. The check was not under control of the Committee once it was sent to the vendor. The funds have now been returned to the Committee by the bank. This will be disclosed on the October 15, 2025 FEC report.
