Dear Ms. Carothers:

I am responding to the December 19, 1996 letter to the Pete King for Congress Committee from John D. Gibson, Assistant Staff Director, Reports Analysis Division.

In the area of apparant excess contributions from individuals, I submit redesignation authorizations from four of the five individuals cited. I continue to pursue the fifth, Mr. Perry Waitz.

With regard to apparantly excess contributions from NATCA PAC and its affiliated committees, MEBA-PAF and NMU-LOW, I enclose a copy of a refund check in the amount of \$400.


With respect to prohibited contributions from the Emerald Society PDNY (actually shoud read PDNY) and AFGE Local 2693, I have enclosed copies of refund checks.

With respect to a contribution from Iron Workers Local 40, an explanation is in order. The check was made out to the Seaford Republican Club but got mixed in with other checks intended for the Pete King for Congress Committee and was deposited with them. When I discovered the error, I immediately directed that a check be sent to the Seaford Republican Club. Copies of the original check from Iron Workers Local 40 and my committee's check to the Seaford Republicans are enclosed.

With respect to Oxford Leasing, I enclose a copy of a refund check.




