Please amend your report to clarify the change made in Line 6(a). (52 U.S.C. §30104(b)(1) (formerly 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(1)) and 11 CFR §104.3(a)(1))

- Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) of your report discloses one or more disbursement(s) for apparent operating expenditures. However, you have also disclosed "Carey Account" for this disbursement(s). For your information and consideration when preparing future filings, please be advised that administrative and other expenditures made from the Non-Contribution account should be properly disclosed on Schedule B supporting Line 29 with "Non-Contribution Account" in memo text or the description filed with the purpose of disbursement. Please refer to the "Reporting Guidance for Political Committees that Maintain a Non-Contribution Account" at <http://www.fec.gov/pages/fecrecord/november2011/fecstatementcareyvfec.shtml> when determining the proper categorization(s) for your next filing.

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an


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enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
