Dear Mr. Katurinis:

On March 20, 2002 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your March 26, 2002 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-You stated in your response that in the past McGuireWoods LLP has paid the administrative expenses of the PAC. Please indicate whether McGuireWoods LLP continues to pay these expenses.

If so, since your committee is registered as a nonconnected committee rather than a separate segregated fund, the payments would be considered in-kind contributions and would be subject to the disclosure requirements of 2 U.S.C. 434(b)(3) and 11 CFR 104.13, and the limitations and prohibitions of 2 U.S.C. 441a and 441b.

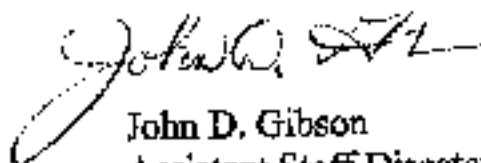
If your committee is actually a separate segregated fund please amend your Statement of Organization to reflect the correct relationship with your connected organization.

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by July 3, 2002. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in

determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions for time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
