This Joint Fundraising Agreement ("Agreement") is made this ____ day of September, 1998, between the following organizations: Baker for Congress, an unincorporated association located at P.O. Box 10488, Rock Hill, SC; Fletcher for Congress '98, an unincorporated association located at P.O. Box 4703, Suite 105, Lexington, KY; Mike Ferguson for Congress, an unincorporated association located at 340 North Avenue East, Suite 6, Cranford, NJ; Gary Hofmeister for Congress Committee, an unincorporated association located at P.O. The entity formed by this Joint Fundraising Agreement will be known as the New Conservative Leadership Fund ("NCLF") and will register with the Federal Election Commission as a political committee.

The NCLF intends to hold a series of joint fundraising events during 1998, in accordance with the provisions of the Federal Election Commission ("FEC") Regulations, at 11 C.F.R. § 102.17.

1. These 20 committees agree to form a joint fundraising committee pursuant to 11 C.F.R. § 102.17(b)(1) to act as the Fundraising Representative. All events shall be a joint fundraising event for the following:

Baker for Congress, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 17th District of the State of Illinois.

Charles Ball for Congress, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election

for the United States House of Representatives from the 10th District from of the State of California.

Molly Bordonaro for Congress '98, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 1st District of the State of Oregon.

Committee to Elect Mike Burkhold to Congress, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 5th District of the State of South Carolina.

Mike Ferguson for Congress, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 6th District of the State of New Jersey.

Fletcher for Congress '98, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 6th District of the State of Kentucky.

Gary Hofmeister for Congress Committee, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 10th District of the State of Indiana.

Delbert Hosemann for Congress Committee, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 4th District of the State of Mississippi.

Texans for Rudy Izzard, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 17th District of the State of Texas.

Jean Leising for Congress, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 9th District of the State of Indiana.

McCormick for Congress, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 2nd District of the State of Georgia.

Pirozzi for Congress, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 42nd District of the State of California.

Bill Randall for Congress, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 3rd District of the State of Florida.

Ryan for Congress, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 1st District of the State of Wisconsin.

Don Sherwood for Congress, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 10th District of the State of Pennsylvania.

Simpson for Congress, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 2nd District of the State of Idaho.

A Lot of People Who Want Gex "Jay" Williams in Congress, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§

431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 4th District of the State of Kentucky.

Phil Wyrick for Congress, a political committee registered with the FEC as a principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §§ 431(5) and 432(e)(2), for the 1998 election for the United States House of Representatives from the 2nd District of the State of Arkansas.

These parties will hereinafter be referred to individually as "Entity" or collectively as the "New Conservative Leadership Fund" or "NCLF". All checks for events held will be made payable to "The New Conservative Leadership Fund."

II. The proceeds from activities of the NCLF shall be processed and allocated as set forth in this Paragraph II. All contributions permissible under the Federal Election Campaign Act ("FECA"), 2 U.S.C. § 431 et seq., shall be allocated as set forth in Paragraphs II(A) and II(B). Any contribution not permissible under the FECA will be returned to the donor pursuant to 11 C.F.R. § 103.3(b)(1). Any contribution which would cause that donor to exceed his or her FECA limits with respect to an Entity will be reallocated as set forth in Paragraph II(B).

A. Subject to the provisions below, all contributions to the NCLF permissible under the FECA will be divided equally among the Entities, with each Entity receiving one-twentieth (1/20) of the net fundraising proceeds. Except as set forth below, any contribution exceeding any applicable limits or otherwise not permissible under the FECA will be returned to the donor.

B. All contributions permissible under the FECA but that would cause a contributor to exceed any applicable Federal contribution limit to an Entity, will be reallocated equally to the other Entities.

C. Any contributor may designate that his or her contribution go to any of the Entities, to the extent permissible by law. Any designated contribution which exceeds the contributor's limit to the designated participant will not be reallocated by The New Conservative Leadership Fund, absent the prior written permission of the contributor, as required by 11 C.F.R. § 102.17(c)(6)(ii).

D. Any contributor may make his or her contribution payable directly to any of the Entities which are parties to this Agreement.

III. Expenses for the event shall be paid from the gross receipts for the event.

A. Each Entity shall pay a portion of the total expenses of the event proportional to its actual share of total revenue from the event to which it is entitled pursuant to Paragraph II above.

B. Distribution of proceeds from the event shall occur only after the Treasurer of The New

Conservative Leadership Fund certifies in writing that:

- 1) all expenses have been paid or sufficient reserves have been set aside to pay them;
- 2) each entity has paid a share of expenses to date equal to its share of the proceeds.

IV. The NCLF hereby agrees expressly to conduct its activities in accordance with the requirements of 11 C.F.R. § 102.17, including specifically the following:

A. Supervise preparation of a Fundraising Notice in substantially the form contained in Schedule A of this Agreement. The Notice shall set forth the names of the participating Entities, the allocation formula, and a statement informing prospective contributors that their contribution will be reallocated to comport with contribution limits applicable to the participating Entities, pursuant to 11 C.F.R. § 102.17(c)(6)(i). The Fundraising Notice shall contain a signature line to authorize such reallocation pursuant to 11 C.F.R. § 102.17(6)(ii), as well as all disclaimers required by law. This Notice and any and all fundraising communications made or distributed by any party shall be approved in advance by each Entity.

B. Maintain as many separate depository accounts as required by 11 C.F.R. § 102(c)(3), and provide each of the participating Entities all information necessary for them to amend their Statements of Organization.

C. Comply with all fundraising, depository, recordkeeping and reporting requirements of the FECA.

D. Organize and conduct the event in consultation with each Entity, and pay all expenses of the event, either from the gross proceeds of the event or from funds advanced by the participating Entities if the gross proceeds are insufficient.

E. Perform such other acts as are reasonably necessary for the successful operation of the event.

V. Each Entity shall comply at all times with all applicable Federal laws, and each indemnifies the other from any liability arising out of any breach of this covenant by that Entity. This warranty shall survive the term of this Agreement.

VI. This document constitutes the entire Agreement of the Entities. The Agreement may be amended or modified only in writing, signed by an authorized representative of the Entities. The individuals signing this Agreement are authorized to do so and to bind each of the Entities, but each signs this document only in his or her representative capacity. The Entities appoint the following people as representatives of each Entity in all matters relevant to the administration of this Agreement:

The NCLF and each Entity shall be entitled to rely on instructions or other communication received from these representatives until that Entity has received written notice, at the address first set forth herein, that the representative has been replaced; any such notice shall include the name of his or her successor. Any action taken or not taken in actual reliance upon such valid instructions or communications shall be binding on the Entities.

VIII. This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia. If any portion of this Agreement is declared invalid by any competent court or authority having jurisdiction, the remainder of the Agreement shall be at all times in full force and effect.

IX. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to create any relationship other than a joint venture between the Entities, and no third party shall acquire any rights from or in consequence of this Agreement, except as shall appear expressly herein. No Entity may assign any part of its rights or obligations under this Agreement without the advance written consent of the others, which may be withheld for any reason.

X. This Agreement may be executed in multiple forms, any of which shall constitute an original version for all purposes.
