Dear Federal Election Committee:


I am writing to you to ask for your assistance in clearing up what appears to have been some confusion as to previously filed Statements of Candidacy. Enclosed please find the Statement of Candidacy which I filed on May 21, 1997 with regard to a possible congressional run in the 4th District of Iowa. [Exhibit 1] I was advised by Greg Scott of your office that it was not necessary for me to file any reports or send in organizational information if I had not decided to become a candidate at that time. After receiving this information, I informed the Committee via a letter sent on July 29, 1997, a copy of which is enclosed. [Exhibit 2] At that time, I asked for you to withdraw my name as a candidate in Iowa's 4th District.

Since that time, I have moved back to my hometown of Dubuque, Iowa and have declared that I am a candidate for Iowa's 2nd District congressional seat. [See Exhibit 3] I would appreciate it if you would close my file as it relates to the 4th District Statement of Candidacy as I have withdrawn that, and have been informed by the Committee on Standards of Official Conduct, as well as the Office of the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives, specifically the Legislative Resource Center, that they have been confused as to what date on which my financial disclosure statement was required. Please contact Janice Glosson of the Legislative Resource Center as she is aware of the mix-up and would like to clear up the paperwork for the Committee. 
