Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) of your report discloses totals of \$7,456.75 and \$4,386.76 in payments made to apparent credit card companies; however, the sum of the memo entries provided identifying the original vendors associated with these payments total \$11,920.31 and \$7,343.83, respectively. Please amend your report to clarify this apparent discrepancy.

2. Please amend Schedule B supporting Line 23 by providing the office sought (House, Senate or President), state and congressional district, if applicable for each contribution made. 11 CFR \$104.3(b)(3)(ii) and (v)

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
