This committee prefaces its responses to the October 1, 2012 Request For Additional Information by noting that the past Treasurer(s) did not provide full and complete data to the committee, including an up to date .dcf file, and that the lack of adequate recordkeeping makes it difficult to determine the answers to each question, and makes it impossible to amend this report. \*\*\*Question 1: The Committee has disclosed the expenditures relevant to each of the 5 primary elections listed on Schedule E>. The Year-to-date expenditure tabulation is an automatically calculated function in FEC File that is not subject to the Committee's control. The Committee does not know why the FECfile software did not tabulate the transactions properly to provide accurate Calendar Year-To-Date Per Election for Office Sought totals for each primary election. The Committee does not have the underlying .dcf file used to create this report and cannot amend it, but notes that the individual expenditures are themselves reported on Schedule E, and concurs with the totals noted by the Commission in its RFAI. Some expenditures were entered after the date of the subject election, but this does not appear to be the source of the error. \*\*\*Question 2: (a) The CTV Media expenditure is the same transaction reported as being to the Vista Partnership, reported on Schedule E (page 196). This transaction was first reported, on a paper filing, as being on January 4, 2012, later amended to January 5, 2012, and postmarked and sent via overnight delivery on January 6, 2012. Absent historical records, the Committee believes that CTV Media was the ultimate recipient of the funds and is part of, or was disbursed through, or has as an agent, the Vista Partnership. (b) The Redhouse Motion expenditure correctly appears on Schedule E (page 187) as being for South Carolina and made on 11/11, and incorrectly appears on the 24 hour notice reported on January 17 as being for Florida and made on 11/10, but includes in the descriptive text that it is for South Carolina TV. This appears to be a clerical error requiring an amendment to that 24 hour report. (c) The Viva Media expenditure appears on the January 17 24-hour report as being incurred on January 13, 2012, and is further reported on Schedule E (page 191) when paid on January 24, 2012. \*\*\*Question 3: as noted above, the Redhouse expenditure appears on Schedule E at page 187 (there is an amendment required to the 24 hour report which incorrectly lists FL, not SC, as the primary). The Viva Media expenditure is reported as an expenditure to CTV Media on Schedule E, page 196. Absent historical records, the Committee believes that CTV Media was the ultimate recipient of the funds and is part of, or was disbursed through, or has as an agent, Viva Media. \*\*\*Question 4: The 24-hour report is a typed recreation of the 24-hour report filed on January 6, 2012 that was filed in response to the February 8, 2012 RFAI whose response date was March 14, 2012. This is not a unique or new Report.
