Re: Terminating the Green Party of Pinellas County reporting requirements

Dear Mr. Gibson:

I am presently the duly appointed treasurer. Please be advised that I am having considerable difficulty terminating the FEC reporting obligation of Green Party of Pinellas County (GPPC) to file FEC reports. In effect, it appears that the GPPC became directly involved in the presidential campaign in 2000. In 2001 I became active in the GPPC and the former treasurer turned over responsibilities of treasurer to me.

It is clear to me that this whole procedure is way over my head. I attempted to file a report by mail and I was notified that it was not accepted and that I had to file electronically. My efforts to file electronically have been failures as well. I also came to realize that since the GPPC is not involved in any federal election campaigns, we should have terminated the file immediately after the 2000 elections. We have determined that should GPPC members wish to support a federal candidate those individuals should form an independent committee.


Since the 2000 national elections the GPPC has operated more as an activist club and has not and will not be involved directly in any federal election campaigns. Since the November, 2000 elections, we have not collected or accepted any political campaign contributions. Since the November, 2000 elections we have not made any payments for any federal campaigns. I have

therefore attempted to file a termination report. I have a call in now to technical support because I know that some how I must somehow file this report and end this matter. Please review the report and if there are any problems or difficulties, contact me.

I will honestly tell you I am totally confused and unsure of myself in this matter. I want only to terminate this matter, as quickly as possible. I am need your assistance to help us official terminate our federal reporting requirements. I am also asking for forbearance in this matter, as the GPPC has not been collecting or spending any federal campaign contributions since November, 2000.
