Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 item(s):

1. Schedule B supporting Line 22 discloses refunds of contributions received from "IDAHO REALTORS Political Action Committee," "IOWA Realtors PAC," "OREGON RPAC," and "TENNESSEE RPAC." However, it appears that these contributions were not previously reported by your committee. Please amend the appropriate reports(s) to disclose the original contributions or provide clarifying information. (52 U.S.C. §30104(b) (formerly 2 U.S.C. §434(b)) and 11 CFR § 104.3(a) & (b))

The Commission notes the memo text attached to your report stating, "For Line 22 of this report, the disbursements to Iowa Realtors PAC for \$450.00 on 9/26/17, Idaho Realtors Political Action Committee for \$30.00 on 9/26/17, Oregon RPAC for \$1,000.00 on 9/07/17, Tennessee RPAC for \$225.00 on 9/05/17 and Tennessee RPAC for \$52.50 on 9/27/17 represent refunds for transmissions of funds inadvertently sent in error by the respective state agent." Although the Commission may take further legal action concerning this matter, your clarification and any additional clarification you may have will be taken into consideration. 11 CFR §104.3

2. On Schedule B, you have disclosed disbursements to federal candidate committees. Commission regulations require that these itemized disbursements include the recipient's full name, complete address, date, amount, state of election, office sought (House, Senate, or President), and district (if applicable).

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Please amend your report to include the state of election, office sought (House, Senate, or President), and district (if applicable). (11 CFR §104.3 (b)(3))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
