This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. 1. Itemized disbursements must include a brief statement or description of why each disbursement was made. Please amend Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) of your report to clarify the following description: "PAC Fundraising Incentive Items." For further guidance regarding acceptable purposes of disbursement, please refer to 11 CFR 104.3(b)(3)(i).

- Your committee has previously indicated that it has been using "best efforts" to obtain the full name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer for each contributor; however, this report discloses a significant increase in the number of entries that lack this information. Please amend your report to provide the omitted information or provide an explanation of your efforts in this regard. (11 CFR §§104.3(a)(4)(i) and 104.7)

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an

enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
