Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 item(s):

1. Your report discloses apparent voided contributions from federal candidates totaling \$2,000 on Schedule A supporting Line 17 of the Detailed Summary Page. If the checks written by your committee were not cashed, you should itemize the voided checks on Schedule B supporting Line 23 as negative entries. Line 16 should be used if the recipient committee cashed your check and wrote a refund on its account. Please amend your report to correct this discrepancy or provide clarification regarding these transactions. (52 U.S.C. ?30104(b)(2) and 11 CFR ?104.3(a)(2)(vii))
2. On Schedule B supporting Line 22, you have itemized disbursements for which you have failed to include the address. Please amend your report to include the missing information. (11 CFR ? 104.3(b)(3))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**
