This letter is in response to the Commission's request for additional information related to the disclosure of independent expenditures that appeared on 24-hour reports but not on Schedule E supporting Line 24 of the Detailed Summary Page and financial activity that was disclosed on the wrong line number of the above referenced report filed by the Service Employees International Union Committee on Political Education (SEIU COPE).

The committee has reviewed its financial activity from the 2010 election cycle and determined that the two independent expenditures disclosed on 24-hour reports were only estimated expenses at the time the 24-hour notices were filed. The expenditure made in support of Paul Hodes was ultimately paid for by the committee's non-federal account and disclosed on a FEC Form 5, filed on 10/29/2010. The expenditure made in support of Robin Carnahan was also paid for out of the committee's non-federal account and will be disclosed on an amended Year-End FEC Form 5. The Committee's FEC identification number for Form 5 filings is C90012105.

In addition, the committee has amended the 30-Day Post-General report to disclose the refund from the federal candidate on Schedule A, Line 16.
