In regard to your letter Reference: JULY MONTHLY REPORT (06/01/2011 - 06/30/2011) dated November 8, 2011: 1. Amendments have been made to the JULY MONTHY REPORT to include additional MEMO entries that were

2. The \$10,000 transfer was made to our non-federal account that is not used to finance activity in connection with federal elections. No disbursements from our non-federal account were made to influence the election or defeat of a specific federal candidate. No disbursements from our non-federal account should have been allocated between our federal and non-federal accounts. Our committee makes allocated expenditures exclusively from a federal account established for allocations into which both non-federal and federal transfers are made in accordance with allocation ratios and regulations. Our committee has procedures in place for proper disclosure of such transactions on FEC reports.
