This letter responds to your letter to Robert H. Katz, Treasurer of NALC-PAC (Identification Number: C00145474). We are counsel to American Council of Life Insurance Political Action Committee ("LIFE PAC"). On January 1, 1993, the National Association of Life Companies was merged into American Council of Life Insurance. As a result, NALC-PAC and LIFE PAC "affiliated" political committees on that date. Thereafter, on January 14, 1993, NALC-PAC transferred all of its remaining funds (\$54,119.28) to LIFE PAC and filed a termination report.

Because transfers of funds may be made without limit between affiliated committees (11 C.F.R. § 102.6(a)), the transfer from NALC-PAC to LIFE PAC did not violate the contribution limits. This letter also should serve as an amendment to the Statement of Organization of NALC-PAC to indicate that it was affiliated with LIFE PAC prior to its termination.
