This notice is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 item(s):

1. Schedule B supporting Line 23 of the Detailed Summary Page discloses contributions to "ARKANSAS FOR LEADERSHIP POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE (ARKPAC)," "MORAN VICTORY COMMITTEE," "MR. SOUTHERN MISSOURIAN IN THE HOUSE PAC," "SENATE EAGLE PAC," "TEAM MARSHALL II," and "TUBERVILLE VICTORY FUND"; however, you have also disclosed "Boozman, John," "Moran, Jerry," "SMITH, JASON T," "HAGERTY, BILL," "MARSHALL, ROGER W" and "TUBERVILLE, THOMAS H" for these transactions. Please clarify whether these were earmarked contributions made by your committee through these Joint Fundraising Committees and Leadership PACs to these candidates, or if you made the contribution to the political committee exercising no direction or control over how the funds were to be used. If the latter is the case, please do not include the candidate's name on your report. Please amend your report to clarify the ultimate recipient of this contribution(s). (11 CFR §104.3 (b)(3))

2. On Schedule B, you have disclosed disbursements to federal candidate committees. Commission regulations require that these itemized disbursements include the recipient's full name, complete address, date, amount, state of election, office sought (House, Senate, or President), and district (if applicable). Please amend your report to include the state of election, office sought (House,

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Senate, or President), and district (if applicable). (11 CFR §104.3 (b)(3))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
