This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 1 item(s):

- Your report discloses negative entries from "ANGIE CRAIG FOR CONGRESS" with the purpose of "Original disbursement was to leadership PAC; they deposited to candidate committee; see Form 99" on Schedule B supporting Line 23 of the Detailed Summary Page. If the check written by your committee was not cashed and was made to a Federal political committee, you should itemize the voided check on Schedule B supporting Line 23 as a negative entry. Line 16 should be used if the recipient Federal political committee cashed your check and wrote a refund on its account.

If the check written by your committee was not cashed and was made to a non-federal political committee, you should itemize the voided check on Schedule B supporting Line 23 as a negative entry. Line 16 should be used if the recipient federal committee cashed your check and wrote a refund on its account.
